

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between the Government of the Republic of Italy and the Imperial Government of Iran for the establishment of the Joint Commission for Economic Cooperation.

In view of the cordial relations between the two Countries and in the context of their desire to promote to a greater extent economic cooperation on the basis of mutual benefit, the undersigned have decided to establish a joint Commission for economic cooperation.

The joint Commission will meet annually, alternately in Rome and Teheran and the date of each meeting shall be mutually agreed upon by the two Parties.


The first session of the joint Commission shall be held in Rome on June 5, 1974.

The present understanding regarding the establishment of the joint Commission shall enter into force on the date of its signing.
