

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND
AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ITALY
CONCERNING
ELECTRICAL SUBSTATIONS POLLUTION MONITORING

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand and the
Government of the Republic of Italy;

Within the framework of the Basic Agreement on
Cooperation of February 10, 1983;

Wishing to cooperate on the Electrical Substations
Pollution Monitoring;

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I

1.1 The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand desi-
gnates the Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand, here-
inafter referred to as EGAT, as the agency responsible for the
implementation of its obligations under this Memorandum of
Understanding.

1.2 The Government of the Republic of Italy designates
the Centro Elettrotecnico Sperimentale Italiano, Italy, herein-
after referred to as CESI, as the organization responsible for
the implementation of its obligations under this Memorandum of
Understanding.

ARTICLE II

2.1 The two Governments shall cooperate in the Electrical Substations Pollution Monitoring in Thailand, hereinafter referred to as PROGRAMME.

2.2 The objectives of the PROGRAMME are :

- To increase the reliability of the Power System.
- To eliminate the problem of flashovers caused by pollution.
- To be capable to monitor on-line the contamination on the insulators surface for reconditioning it.

2.3 The PROGRAMME is planned to be carried out in a timespan lasting about twelve months.

ARTICLE III

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand, in accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations, shall make the following contributions:

- Buildings, establishment and erection to set up the monitoring system (climatic chamber, site protection, electric feeding).
- Work offices in the substations.
- Local transportation, telex, telephone.
- Local professional staff.

ARTICLE IV

4.1 The Government of the Republic of Italy, in accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations, shall make the

following contributions:

- Turn-key supply of the monitoring system.
- Technical assistance for know-how transfers.
- Laboratory tests for determination of the insulator withstand of the maximum permissible pollution level.
- On-site calibration.

4.2 The total amount of the grant will be specified through Exchange of Notes after the contract between the Thai implementing agency and the appointed Italian company has been signed.

ARTICLE V

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand will assure to the Italian experts working in Thailand for the execution of the PROGRAMME by :

- exempting the Italian experts from income taxes derived from their activities under the PROGRAMME;
- exempting the Italian experts from customs duties on personal effects imported within six months after the first arrival of the experts in Thailand;
- assisting the Italian experts and their dependents with respect to any necessary entry and exit visas, stay permits, and other documents required for their stay and services in Thailand.

ARTICLE VI

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand will :

- facilitate prompt clearance of any equipment, materials or supplies required for the services and of

- the personal effects of the Italian experts, except those banned for import;
- exempt from customs duties and taxes on the importation of the equipment, materials and supplies required for the implementation of the PROGRAMME.

ARTICLE VII

The two Governments and their designated implementing organizations (EGAT and CESI) shall ensure that this Memorandum of Understanding is carried out with due diligence and efficiency and each shall furnish the other with all information that may be considered necessary for the realization of the PROGRAMME.

ARTICLE VIII

8.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of signature and shall expire upon completion of the PROGRAMME or on any date mutually agreed upon by the two Governments.

8.2 This Memorandum of Understanding which is stipulated in accordance with ARTICLE III of the Basic Agreement on Co-operation Between the Kingdom of Thailand and the Republic of Italy is of a technical nature and is intended only to set out the administrative responsibility of the two Governments in relation to the carrying out of the PROGRAMME within the framework of the abovementioned Basic Agreement on Co-operation between the two countries.

8.3 This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time with the mutual consent of both Governments by Exchange of Letters.


8.4 Any dispute arising out of the interpretation or im-

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Undersigned, have signed this Memorandum of Understanding.


